- Integration and inclusion foster friendships among the same age peer group.

Preparation for The Attributes of God Lessons for the Month of September

Lesson Outline: Week 1

- God prohibited any carved images of Him. This teach us that the Divine Nature of God is beyond any physical form that we see.
- God is Spirit. Spirits are above gender, which pertains to the earthly flesh.
- God is Eternal. He is beyond temporal limits. He has neither beginning, nor end, nor duration.


Objective: Explore some Divine attributes, concentrating upon a number of inquiries that arose throughout history and in our modern period.
